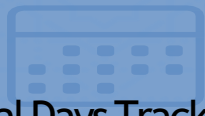

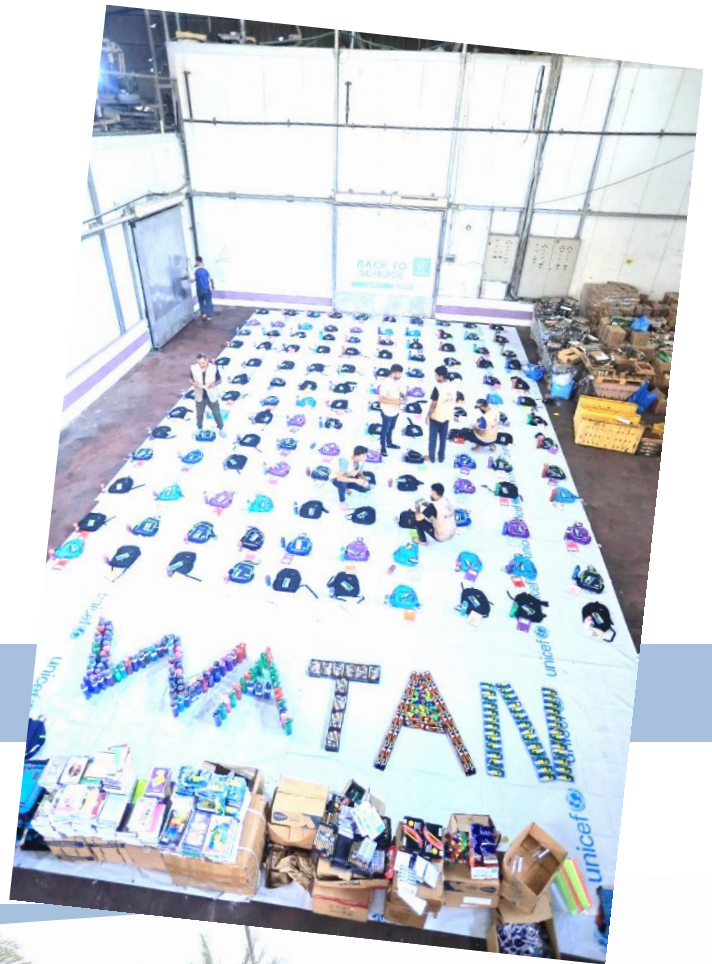

CONSISTENT SUPPORT WHERE IT MATTERS MOST

By August 2026, support reached communities through **3,000** food packs, **161,150** hot meals, **2,640** infant formula packages, **60,000 ltrs** of drinking water distributions, and **6,125** school packs.



Because of generous contributions,

232,915

beneficiaries were honored during August 2026.



The supported communities benefited from a range of activities across several countries: In Indonesia, assistance included visits to **10 special cases** to provide targeted support, the distribution of **50 prayer mats, 50 Qurans, 100 food packs, and 50 school bags** for orphans, as well as 500 Back-to-School kits. In addition, **500 Back-to-School kits** were distributed in Bangladesh, **400** in Africa, and **400** in Yemen, providing essential educational supplies to children and supporting their return to school.

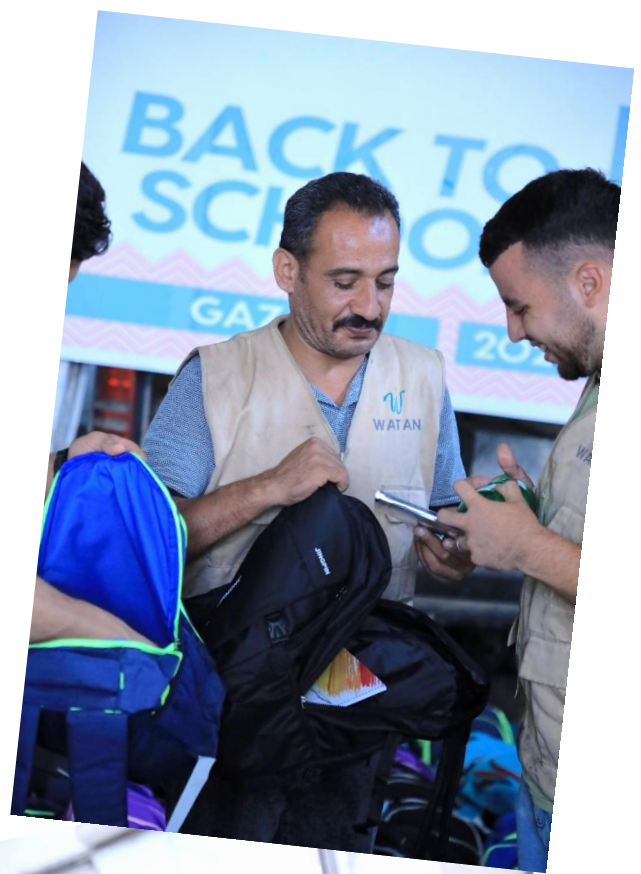


Providing educational saving sustenance for the school year
